

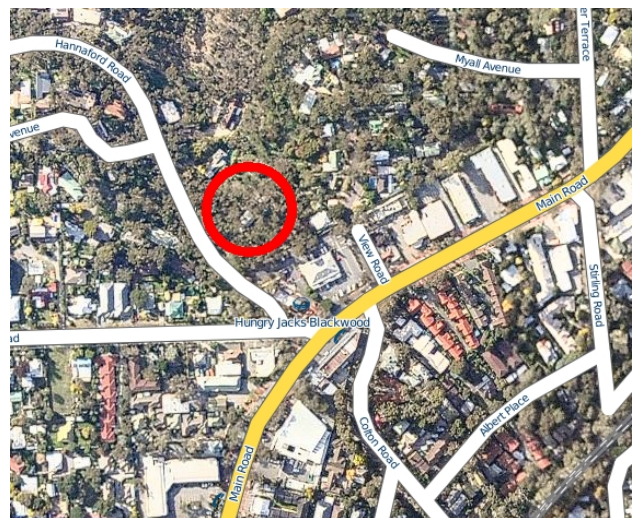
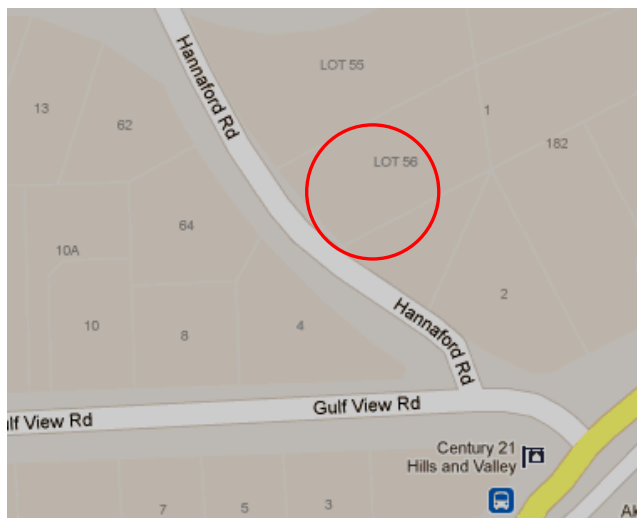
Adelaide Hills Amateur Radio Society (AHARS) Advanced / Standard Amateur Radio Licence Examination

When and what time to meet:

5th May 2019, 1030h

Where to meet:

“The Shack”, Behind Blackwood Girl Guides Hall, Hannaford Road, Blackwood, SA 5051 (see the red circle on the map)



What to bring:

1. **Passport photo:** Current colour, passport size photo on the day of the assessment. Candidate's full name must be clearly printed on the reverse side.
2. **Assessment fees:**
Credit card payable in advance to University of Tasmania (UTas) at www.amc.edu.au/industry/amateur-radio Please bring with you the proof of payment with receipt number on the day of the assessment.
Cash, money order, cheque or credit card payable to UTas the morning of the assessment (See table under for charges. **consult me** before making out the cheque).

\$10 admin fees to be paid in cash to the club for incidentals

Note: ACMA will invoice you separately for the licence fees (~\$76 for new licences or \$52 for renewals per annum).

3. **Personal identification** : Drivers licence, passport, student card or employment ID card (in the absence of a photo ID then atleast any one of – Medicare card, Credit card or Pensioner card and Electricity, Gas or Telephone account showing name and address)

Candidates under 16 are required to produce a Student Photo ID, Passport, Medicare card or parent/guardian photo ID.

4. If you have a Foundation or Standard licence, please bring along a copy of the licence. Alternatively, if you have passed any component of the assessment, a copy of the proof of passing should be brought along.
5. Pens, pencils, erasers, rulers, watch and a calculator (mobile phone as a calculator is prohibited)
6. Something to eat might be a good idea!

Exam information:

Duration of examination

Advanced / Standard theory paper : 90 minutes

Advanced / Standard regulations paper: 30 minutes

Practical assessment : 40 minutes (exempt if you have a foundation / standard licence)

Choosing callsign:

Give some thought on what call sign you would like to have. You will need to state your preferences on the paper work that you put in on the day of the exam. The format of your call sign would be VK5*** The three * are two / three letters of your choice (for eg., VK5AAA)
