

Leigh, a leading member of the AR community in this state, died at home, on 16/10/2022, after a long illness, in the care of his wife, Glenda.

Leigh was influential in many AR and related matters: he had patents in several devices, including RFID, and often appeared at patent infringement hearings.

With Professor Mike Underhill, (**G3LHZ**) he worked, inter alia, on the early development of Magnetic loop antennas. In 2008, Mike co-hosted a symposium on Magnetic Loop antennas with Leigh.
