The 'Shack' was attacked by a determined group of morons on last Friday week, fortunately they did not get into our building, but damaged the door and cladding on the building that we need to repair. They managed to break the pad bolt and lock off the storage shed and decimated the contents, used the tent pegs etc to try and break into our area, even trying to peel off the cladding on the second door (which was welded up during the build). 10 litre paint can (with the green paint we use to cover the grafitti) over the pavers under the carport and managed to mangle the rear door of the Guide Hall.

The police were called by Roy on the Saturday morning, they sent down a forensic team to take photos and samples of finger prints, DNA samples from the cups and straws, bongs and other implements plus the footprints from the spilt paint area but they have not got back to us yet !

An emergency committee meeting taken place by e-mail has decided to instigate a security patrol to pay the site daily visits 3 times a day, starting in the early evening and the others later in the evening at irregular time, concentrating around the Friday nights when it seems most of the damage occurs. This will happen for 2 months to establish that the area is being monitored, this will give us time to repair and harden the site against this sort of moronic behaviour. I have been in touch with the new CEO of GGuides Australia here in Adelaide, she is coming down for a meeting on Saturday with Roy, Jim and myself, so it would be nice for her to see that we,as a Club are doing good things at the site which will promote our suitability for a longer tenancy.

There will be a further meeting with the Committee with one of our members that has the expertise in how to harden sites against this sort of attack, and we will probably need to install cameras and a GSM call system, to notify us and the police of the unwanted presence of undesirables. There will be more to follow !
