

6.2 APPOINTMENT OF OFFICERS

The committee shall be composed of the Executive and other officers of the society.

- a). The Executive Officers of the society shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer, who shall be Members and who may, if there is no nomination for all of these posts, occupy more than one office. These officers shall form the Executive. **(Vide 6 a)**).
- b). The President: A member may be elected to the position of President for a maximum of three consecutive years provided however, that there is a nomination by another member eligible for election to that position. In the event that there are no nominations for the position and the retiring President is willing to continue, then he/she will be eligible for re-election without nomination as per 6.2 i).
- c). The Vice President deputises for the President in his/her absence.
- d). The Secretary shall keep minutes of committee and other meetings, and handle and record correspondence.
- e). The Treasurer shall keep books of accounts and compile financial reports.
- f). A committee member shall be a natural person.
- g). The committee may appoint a member to fill a casual vacancy, and such a committee member shall hold office until the next annual general meeting of the society and shall be eligible for election to the committee without nomination.
- h). The committee may appoint non-elected officials to various posts as deemed required by the committee for the effective running of the society.

Nominations.

- i). A retiring committee member shall be eligible to stand for re-election without nomination. No other person shall be eligible to stand for election unless a member of the society has nominated that person at least 28 days before the meeting by delivering the nomination of that person to the secretary of the society. The nomination shall be signed by the proposer and by the nominee. Nominees may be nominated for more than one position, but, subject to 6.2 a), must accept the first position to which they are elected.
- j). Notice of all persons seeking election to the committee shall be given to all members of the society with the notice calling the meeting at which the election is to take place.
